1	Application Form (Form A) – Submit it as a file <u>and</u> fill out an online form
2	Essay (Form B) * Please type. You can use the form provided or supply other forms
3	High Resolution Photo Image (JPEG data - 3:4 <u>ratio</u>) – Upload it onto our Dropbox * Photo must be a formal, passport-type photo taken within 3 months against an off-white, cream or light grey plain background. * Photo must be of high resolution * State your first and last name along with your home institution's name when you upload your photo (i.e. John Smith Nagasaki University of Foreign Studies)
4	Official Academic Transcript * Please include an official transcript of all university academic records.
5	Financial Documentation ● Financial Statement (Form C) ● Supporting Official Financial Documents (Bank Statement, Scholarship Statement, Financial Aid Statement for the study abroad semester etc.)
6	2 Recommendation Letters (Form D)
7	Health Form (Form E① for student, FormE② for doctor) * We cannot be responsible for situations that may arise as the result of your failure to provide complete and accurate information about your health conditions.
8	(For Home Stay Applicants) Home Stay Form and Points of Understanding for a Successful Home Stay (Form F) Unavailable for 2022 Spring
9	Photocopy of passport (If you hold one) * If you have a current passport, please send a photocopy of the information page(s) which shows your name, the expiration date, issuing authority, etc. * If you do not have a passport, you should begin the process of obtaining one immediately.
10	(For Non-Native Speakers of English) Proof of English language ability such as language test results or an official letter from your lecturer of English stating your English language ability.
11	(For exchange students) Exchange Student Notification (Form G)

IMPORTANT

- * An application will not be considered until ALL materials have arrived at the NUFS International Center in an acceptable form.
- * Any documents submitted in languages other than English or Japanese must be accompanied by an English or Japanese translation.
- * Applicants must
 - 1) Have successfully completed at least one year of university study.
 - 2) Be in good academic standing at their university.
 - 3) Have adequate English ability to participate in the English-language Japan Studies classes.
