

## (JASIN Program Fall Term 2010)

### Kotobuki Dormitory for male student

This building is four-story building and there are 34 rooms on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. This dormitory can accommodate the International students of our university.

**Rooms:** 34 rooms

#### **Facilities:**

Each room is provided with air conditioner, bedclothes, refrigerator.

The size of each room is 4.5 tatami mats. (7.3 m<sup>2</sup>)

Shower-toilet room, washing machine and kitchen are shared with other students.

\* Each room is equipped with a LAN outlet for Internet connection. It is possible to get a connection if you are willing to go through the application process and wait about two months for the service to begin. Students can also choose to use Wi-max in the dormitory and elsewhere.

**Fees:** 22,000 yen per month (21,000 yen for rent, 1,000 yen for utilities for common space)

Initially, there are three fees due totaling: 25,000 yen

- 1) Insurance fee for damage to the facilities
- 2) Cleaning for room
- 3) Bed Clothes

Other costs, shower : 100 yen / 10 minutes

washing machine : 200 yen

electric utility fee in student's own room,

Internet,

**Meal:** No meals are provided. Students can prepare food in the kitchen or eat out.

**Transportation:** It takes about 15 minutes by bus from this dormitory to the university.

One way: 140 yen. The free school bus also runs from near the dormitory to the university. Students can use the school bus if the bus schedule meets the class schedule.

**Location :** The location is very convenient.

There are many shops for food and daily necessities, banks, restaurants, post office and hospitals near the dorm.
